MANAGERS/TEAM CAPTAINS CHECK LIST

1. Ensure the team list is correct and confirm any changes with the Tournament Organiser or one of the Tournament Managers prior to your first game.
2. Ensure that the team knows what time their games is and to be ready prior to the start time.
3. Make a roster for duty (see the duty requirements section) for each game your team is to do duty for and have them ready 5 minutes prior and identified to the Referee for the game.
4. Ensure that all Technical information is read, understood and if necessary, carried out.
5. Make sure you have a rubbish bag and that your area and surrounding areas are kept clean. Take your rubbish to the bins at the grounds. Do not leave any rubbish behind.
6. Make sure uniform requirements are met – see the rules section – for each team member.
7. Make sure your team, or your club, has available:
 - A first aid kit
 - Ice
 - Sunscreen
 - Water
 - Gazebo/Marquee for Shelter
8. Ensure priority of player health & wellness. Prepare to report any player safety issues/injuries through the Game Day Player Safety reporting form on the NZAFF [website](#)..

DUTY TEAMS

Duty teams requirements:

All teams will be required to do Duty.

BE READY AT LEAST 5 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE GAME STARTING
AT THE FIELD.

That means:

- Get the game sheet from the admin tent.
- Officials Crew to get their uniforms from the admin tent.
- Get the team signs for the score board.
- Tell the Referee who you are and be ready for any further instructions.
- Make sure score sheets are signed by the referee so scores are verified.
- Return score sheets, signs and uniforms immediately after use.

Each team will be rostered onto game duty and will supply three people:

1. a "Duty Official". See next section below.
2. two other players for scoring and recording.

The requirement for a Duty Official has come about because over half of teams entered were not able to supply an official which means we do not have enough Officials.

This requirement is on all teams irrespective of whether they have supplied a dedicated Team Official.

The Duty Officials will assist the White hats and be the down judge, field judge or the side judge as required.

We expect that duty officials will have had some experience as an Official however if the Official is new to Flag officiating, they must have completed the online learning modules prior to Nationals.

Failure to supply a Duty team will result in a default applied to the team's next game.

TEAM DUTY OFFICIALS ROLES

Your team official may be asked to do one of these roles.

Down Judge (DJ)

Position	The initial position of the Down Judge is on the line of scrimmage at the side line with the down indicator if used .
Basic Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Down Judge is responsible for the operation of the down indicator if used.• The Down Judge shall keep count of the downs.• The Down Judge has jurisdiction (see diagram) over the scrimmage line and their side line to 7 yards down the field.• Watches for offside or encroachment - false starts.• Makes out of bounds calls on his/her sideline.• Must be able to return to the mark if the down is replayed (marks this with a bean bag).
After snap	<p>The Down Judge stays at the line of scrimmage, they have jurisdiction from the LoS to 7 yards downfield.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Once the ball has been snapped, the Down Judge shall be responsible for:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ QB crossing the LOS.○ Shielding, contact flag, guarding, jumping other fouls○ Where the play finishes.• If there is a foul on the play they walk off the penalty yards indicated by the Referee.• Shall “spot the ball” - indicate where the ball should be placed for the next play.

Field Judge (FJ)

Position	The initial position of the Field Judge is 7 yards deep at the sideline opposite to the down indicator.
Basic Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• May be responsible for running the game clock.• The Field Judge has jurisdiction over their side line:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Reminding the Blitz, where the 7-yard line is prior to the snap, If a player crosses the line 7 yards from the LoS with a hand raised above head, before the snap - Illegal Blitz.○ Makes out of bounds calls on his/her sideline.• Marks the 7-yard Blitz point.
After snap	<p>After the snap the FJ will move to mid field while watching the area from 7 yards to down the field to cover deep passes.</p> <p>Once the ball has crossed the line of scrimmage, the Field Judge shall be responsible for ruling on the play around the ball and forward progress on their side of the field.</p>

Side Judge

Position	The initial position of the Side Judge is 20 or more yards deep on the same side as the DJ.
Basic Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Side Judge shall be responsible for observing receivers on deep routes for ruling on long passes and the status of the ball and forward progress in their area. • May be responsible for the 25 sec play clock. • Makes calls for any touchdowns ensuring players are in bounds. • Watches the receivers and defenders for fouls: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Shielding, ○ Contact, ○ Flag Guarding, ○ Jumping and diving ○ Pass interference
After snap	Responsible for observing the receivers on deep routes, ruling on long pass plays, forward progress in their area.

Team Recording Roles

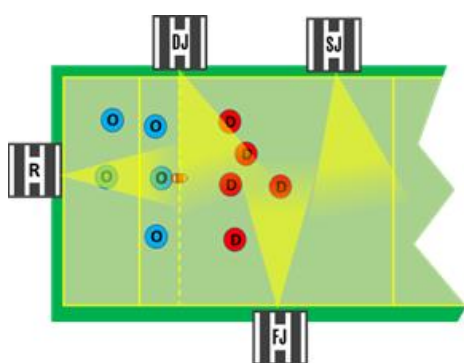
1 or 2 team members required.

The job includes:

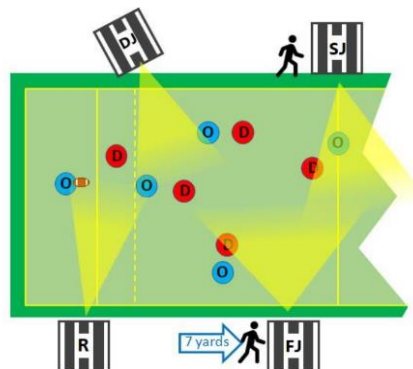
- Time keeping.

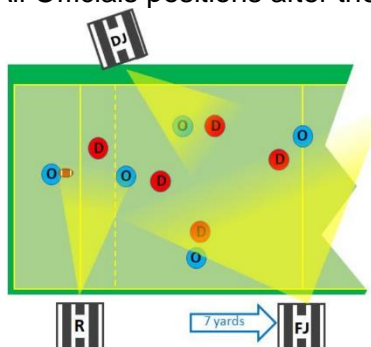
All Officials positions prior to snap.

Infringements and Penalties

Infringement	Official Responsible	Description & what to watch for	Whistle or Flag	The Referee will call the penalty
Blocking	All	Watch for use of the hands, arms, elbows, legs, or body to initiate contact during any play.	Flag	Personal foul, 10 yards at spot of foul
Illegal Contact	All	Contact becomes Illegal when it is Impactful, intentional impactful contact can be considered Aiming. Aiming is an ejectable offence.	Flag	
Pass Interference	DJ FJ SJ	Pass interference is - A player on defence or offence shoving or pushing the opponent -Hooking a player so they aren't able to move like they normally would. -Cutting off the receiver's path to the football without making a play on the football- with no contact is shielding	Flag	
Flag guarding, Jumping & Diving	All	Watch the runner in possession of the ball swinging the hand or arm over the flags or placing the ball over the flag to prevent an opponent from removing the flag. Watch a runner in possession jumping or diving to avoid a tackle.	Flag	5 yards and loss of down at spot of foul
False Start	DJ Ref	Offensive players crossing the Line of scrimmage before the ball is snapped. Offensive players should be set in their positions for 1 complete second before the snap of the ball.	Whistle	5 yards from the previous spot
Illegal Blitz	FJ	If blitzer crosses the 7 yard blitz line with hand still raised before the snap penalty for Illegal blitz. If blitzer starts their blitz from within 7 yards and crosses the scrimmage line this is illegal blitz.	Whistle	5 yards from the line of scrimmage and replay the down.

COMPETITION RULES

These are the rules for the tournament.

Team roster	<p>The team roster limit for the 2024 event is <u>15 players maximum</u>, per team. (<i>Please note this will decrease to a 12 player limit from 2025</i>).</p> <p>The Team Roster must be presented by the 8th March 2024.</p> <p>Team Lists should be built in Sporty, titled “team name” and exported as an excel spreadsheet and sent to admin@nzaff.co.nz.</p> <p>Alterations to the team roster can be made prior to the teams first game of the tournament.</p> <p>Players must be registered with their club through the Sporty registration system.</p> <p>Players must be of good standing with the Club and with NZAFF.</p>
Playing strip	<p>Teams must play in team uniforms and must be neat and tidy.</p> <p>Each player must wear a numbered team uniform jersey for play. Please no duplicate numbering.</p> <p>Uniform is the shirt, visibly numbered, and shorts.</p> <p>Shorts must have NO POCKETS.</p>
Criteria	<p>Teams can only be entered by fully affiliated NZAFF Clubs.</p> <p>The Championships divisions are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open Men & Women Open means any age player can participate. It is over to the clubs to ensure that the skill level is appropriate to play in any division.• Youth - Men & Women 18 and Under. The 18 and under division will be any athlete up to 18 years old on 31st July in the year of competition. E.g. for this season, 1st August 2023 to 31st July 2024, if a player turns 19 between those dates they are in the Open division.• Legends Players that are aged 35 years or older as at the 1st of August 2023. There will be no exceptions to this rule
Multiple teams in grades	<p>If a club has multiple teams in one division:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Players must only play for one of those teams.• Playing strip must be different for each team. <p>Clubs cannot exchange players between teams participating in the same division.</p>
Playing across grades	<p>Players can play across the grades but be aware that the playing schedule will be intense and there will be clashes. Games will start on time and will not wait for players. Nor will the game schedule be altered to accommodate these players.</p> <p>Players who play across grades must be on the team sheet at the start of the tournament. They must also have played at least twice in the preliminary pool play for any team they are registered in. They cannot only play in the rounds after the preliminaries. The reason being – the player cannot choose to only start participating for a team in the final rounds in the division that has, perhaps, the best chance of a placing.</p>
Player Safety Reporting	<p>Clubs will be required to complete Player Safety reporting for all games played by club teams.</p>

Player Safety Reporting, continued	<p>The Club Grant allocation for successfully completing the reporting by the end of the Championship will be \$100 per team entered and completing their allocated game schedule.</p> <p>There will be no grant eligibility for any team that withdraws at any stage of the championship.</p> <p>Successful reporting means:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All games are reported before on the end of the weekend. We strongly recommend Team Managers complete reporting at the end of each game. • All reports are accurate. • Follow-up reporting is updated by the Saturday following the championship - 30th March 2024.
Flags Belts	<p>Only NZAFF supplied Flag Belts can be worn during competition. If you do not have this type of Flag Belt, they can be borrowed from the operations tent. Shrumz/NFL/ Other brand Flag Belts are not permitted.</p>
Team Duty	<p>Each team will be rostered onto game duty and will supply three people:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. a “Duty Official”. See next section below. 4. two other players for scoring and recording. <p>Failure to supply a Duty team will result in a default applied to the team’s next game.</p>

Withdrawals	<p>Participants that withdraw a team from an Event after entries close shall remain liable for and shall forfeit their Event entry fee or deposit.</p>
Forfeiture	<p>A team forfeiting any game may be excluded from any medal (or equivalent) round. A team arriving over five (5) minutes beyond the scheduled start time of any game may be deemed to have forfeited that game.</p>
Other Circumstances	<p>In the Event of other circumstances beyond the control of a team to start a game on time at the scheduled venue NZAFF will liaise with teams to find a suitable alternative.</p>
No Alcohol	<p>No alcohol at the competition venue including on the side lines. This applies to supporters as well as teams. Repercussions will be on the team that is playing or being supported. Failure to comply may result in forfeiture of the game.</p>
Disciplinary	<p>Any issues that require disciplinary actions will be dealt with using the NZAFF Disciplinary rules</p>
Appeals	<p>Appeals to any result or complaints must be notified to NZAFF staff within 30 minutes of the game final whistle and can only be reported by the team coach or manager as identified on the team sheet.</p> <p>Note: On field decisions by the officials cannot be appealed.</p>

PLAYING RULES

These are Game rules variations:

Rules	The rules for this competition run by NZAFF will be those specified by the IFAF unless otherwise noted below and by any further communications. Link to the 2023 IFAF Flag Rules here .
Schedule	All games are scheduled to start every 50 minutes, this applies to all games except for Finals which are scheduled to start every 1 hour and 10 minutes
Game Duration	The games will be made up of two 20-minute halves.
Clock	The clock will be running - not stop clock.
2 Minute	<p>During Pool play the clock will stop at 2 mins of each half for 30 seconds but then will be a running clock to the end of the half/full time. This is so that we can schedule games being played within the allocated time frame.</p> <p>During Semi & Final games however, standard 2 minute rules will apply.</p> <p>In Semi and Finals, Within the last 2 minutes of each half the clock shall stop:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● To award a first down or change of possession.● Penalty enforcement● Ball or runner goes out of bounds.● Pass or fumble touches the ground.● Teammate of the fumbler touches the ball.● Touchdown is scored and for the following Try● Timeout.
Timeouts	There will be one timeout per half in all games except the semi & finals. Semi-finals and finals will have two timeouts per half.
Ranking during rounds	Points ties will be broken by, first the head-to-head result, then the ranking will be determined by the team with the lowest points against total taking preference.
Semis Finals & Finals	For any games where a result is necessary there will be an overtime. This applies to semi-finals and finals only. Please see 2023 Flag Rules Rule 3: Periods and Timing.
Flags Belts	Only NZAFF supplied Flag Belts can be worn during competition. If you do not have this type of Flag Belt, they can be borrowed from the operations tent. Shrumz/NFL/ Other brand Flag Belts are not permitted.
Footballs	Teams must provide their own football for play. The minimum size permitted in the Youth and Open Women Grade is Youth Size. The minimum size permitted in the Open Men and Legend grade is Standard/Adult Size.
Mouth guards	Mouth guards are recommended and not compulsory.
Hats/caps	Caps with hard peaks, worn backwards & floppy hats are permitted. If in doubt, ask the referee before the start of play. Referees have the final say.
